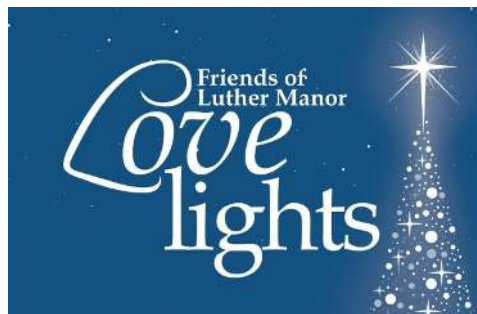


Luther Manor Love Lights

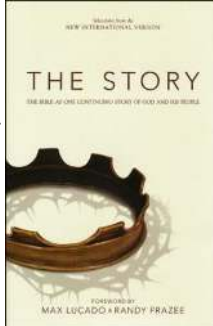

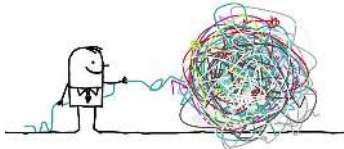

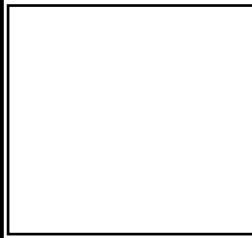
