We are holding a bake sale after each worship service where you will find a fabulous selection of Christmas baked goods. All proceeds will help to offset youth summer mission trip costs.

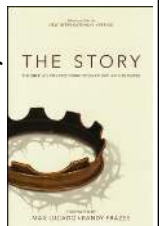
