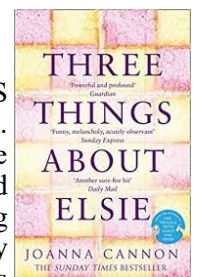


Souper Bowl of Caring


HS TACOS Study and Pancakes!
