The congregation is invited to participate in a Town Hall Meeting on Sunday, December 11, following late service worship to receive the completed Ministry Site Profile. The Ministry Site Profile (MSP for short) is used by synod staff to source pastoral candidates, by pastoral candidates to understand Christ Our Savior, and by the Call Committee to assess pastoral candidates. The purpose of the gathering is for the congregation to verify that the MSP does indeed reflect the congregation's identity and what sort of pastoral leadership it desires to call.

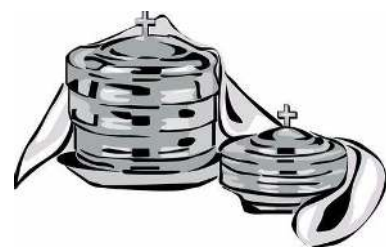
